Western Theatre Foyer Box Office on Ground Level is open one hour prior to performances

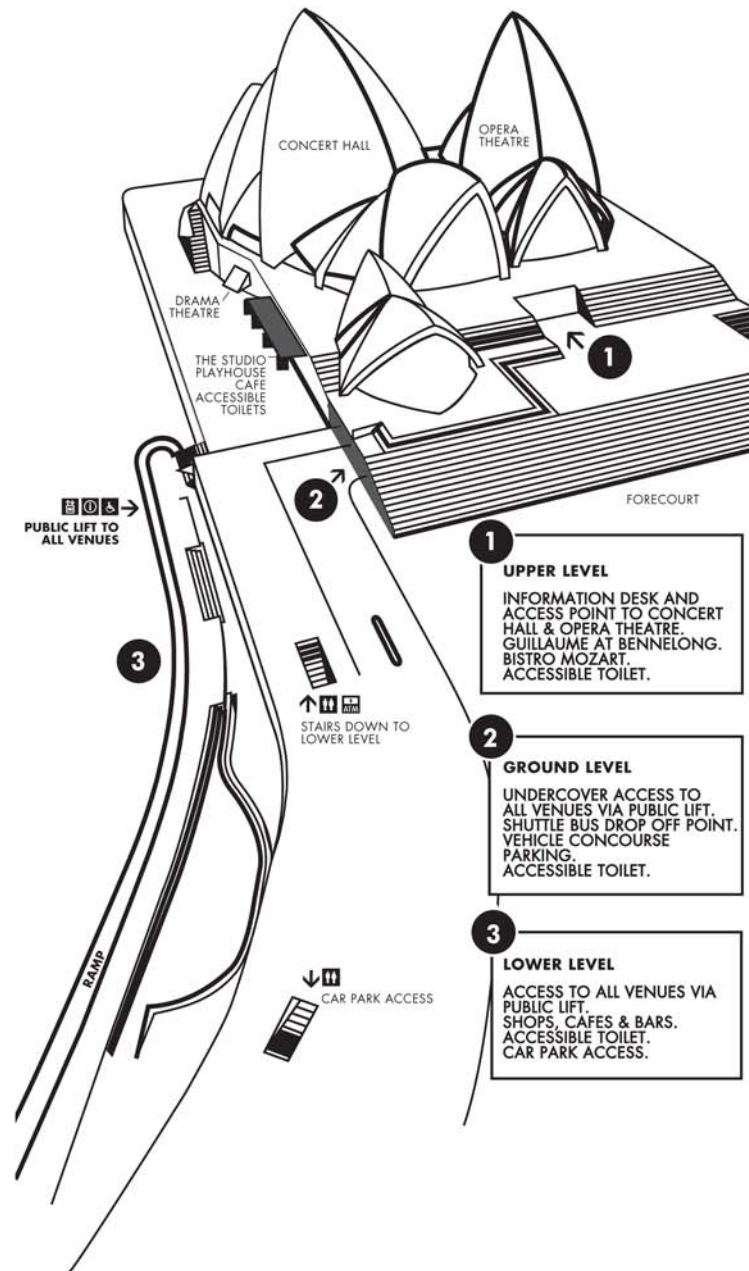
