To help you plan your visit, here are the performances timings

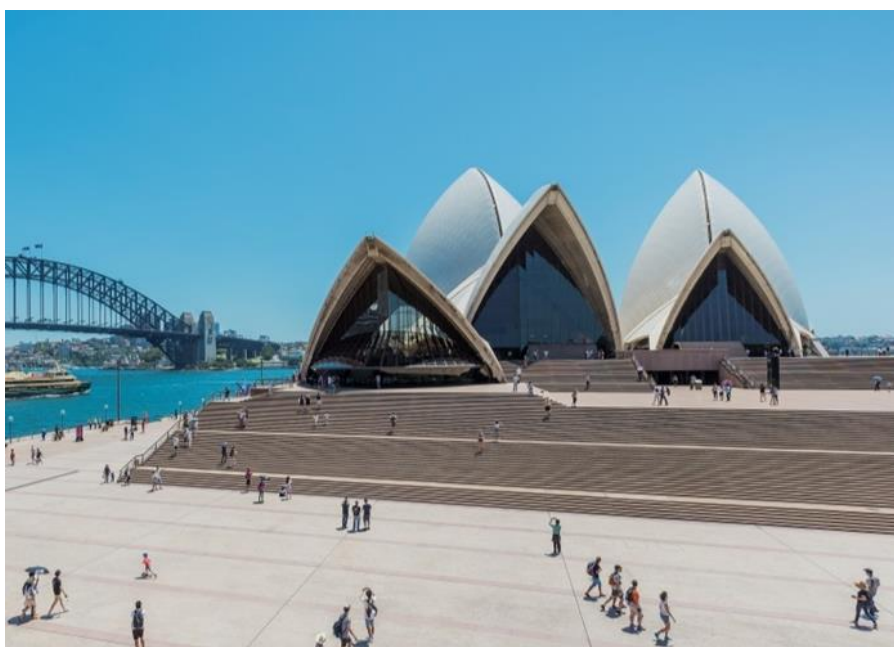
Your health and safety is our priority. Face masks are strongly recommended for patrons 12 years and over while inside our foyers and theatres.

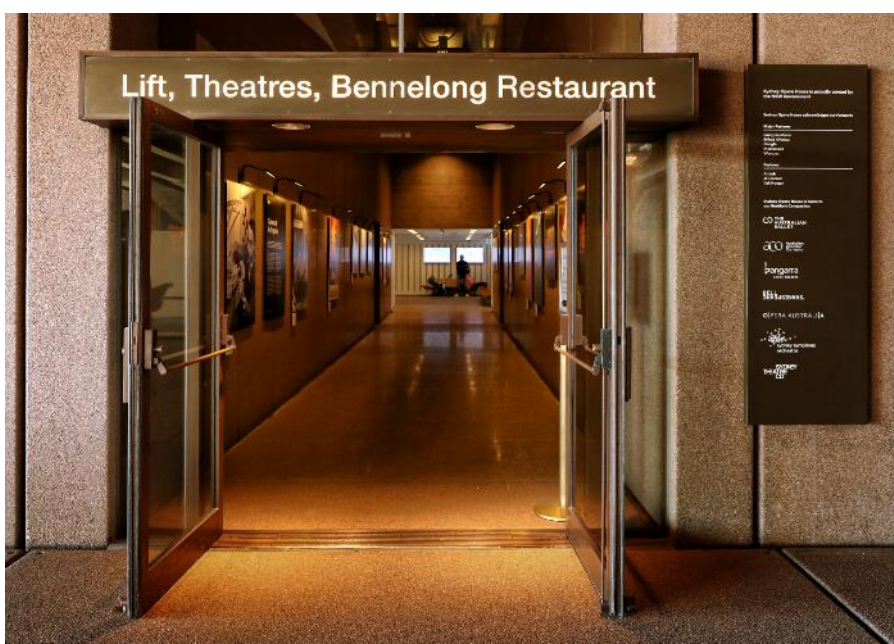

When you arrive at the Sydney Opera House, you will travel across the Forecourt to the entry doors.

Walk under the big stairs and enter the Western Foyer doors.

In front of these entry doors there may be a queue line.

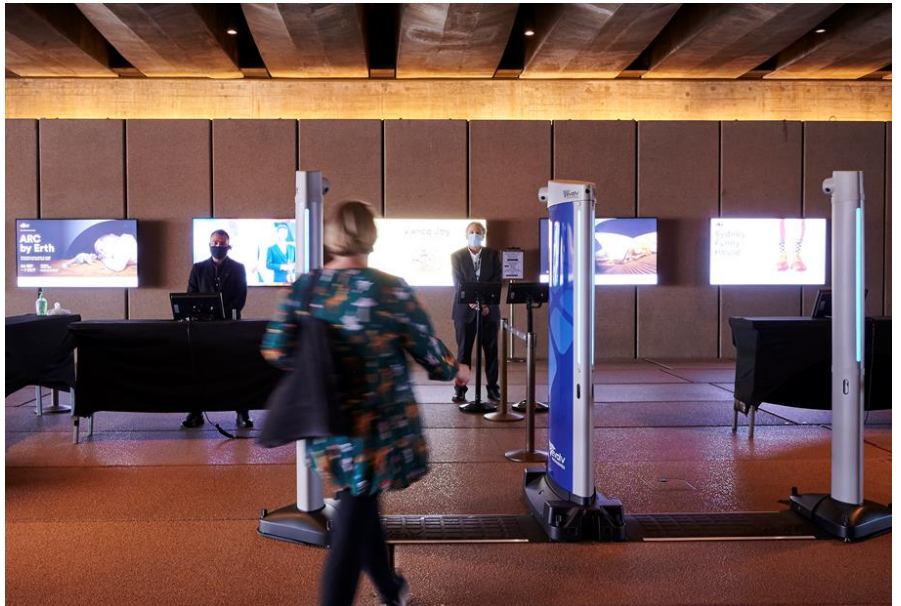
Follow the queue around using the ropes as a guide.

Staff will be available to assist you.

In the queue you will step through an electronic gate. This gate checks for metal items that you might be wearing or have in your bag.

Staff may do a bag inspection.

There are bathrooms at the top of the Western Foyer near the public lifts.

The Studio is located halfway down the Western Foyer.

You may need to collect tickets from the Box Office. There may be a queue.

The show is in the Studio.

The doors will open before the show start time. There may be a queue to enter.

The Sydney Opera House staff will scan your ticket.

The theatre space will be a bit darker than the foyer.

In the Studio your seats may be upstairs or you may go down stairs, or use the lift, to go to the floor level.

You will see a set for the show and hear some music. The performers are waiting backstage.

Soon the show will start and you will meet the performers.
